





4. Numbers Heads Together • Useful for quickly reviewing material • Each member of a team is given numbers 1, 2, 3, 4.

4. Numbers Heads Together Useful for quickly reviewing material Each member of a team le given numbere 1, 2, 3, 4.. Questions are displayed on the slides/board Each team work together to prepare the answer and try to make sure each member knows and able to answer verbally Teacher calls out a number from a team to answer the question Teams are pressure on sink or Swim









7. Circle the Sage (Expert, Experienced)

- Student teaching methods
 - Teacher polls the class to see which students have a special knowledge to share or able to answer/solve a difficult problem
 - Those students (the sages) stand and spread out in the room.
 - Then, the rest of classmates surround those sages, making sure that no two members of the same team going to the same sage.
 - Members return and share their learning.



8. Roundtable

- Used for brainstorming in case study solution
 - Teacher asks a question which has multiple answer and each member writes an answer and passes it on to the next member
 - Teacher displays the correct answer
 - Team with most correct answer rewarded. Teams reflect on their strategies and consider ways to improve

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9. Debate

- Used for having a 360 degree view of a topic
 - Teams are given a position to defend, and then asked to present arguments in support of their position
 - The opposing teams rebut the argument(s) and, the original presenters asked to respond to the rebuttal.
 This format is particularly useful in developing argumentation skills

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10. Panel Discussion

- Team gives class presentations or reports in front of entire class.
 - Teams are assigned a topic to research and asked to prepare presentations or reports.
 - Team presents their findings
 - Floor is opened to questions from "the audience"/classroom.



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Cooperative & Competitive Learning

- Lecture Capture Session (LCS)/Lecture Minutes
- Question Answer Competition (QAC)
- Question Generation Competition (QGC)

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1. Lecture Capture Session (LCS) Similar to "Five Minutes Review" method I call it Lecture Minutes Require empathetic listening Students take notes individually and prepare a lecture minutes.
